With a very clear ambition to manufacture furniture for public interiors, they have invested a great deal of time, energy and resources into design, product development and marketing. This has produced impressive results, with the company now a well known name. Loyal customers can now be found in Europe, USA, the Middle East and Asia.

An important step in the company's development process was our decision to work with external designers. We are continually developing our wide selection of furniture in close and long-term collaboration with some of the foremost designers in Sweden and Europe.

Johanson is deeply committed to its environmental and quality work. The company is certified according to ISO 14001 and they fulfil the requirements for certification by the Swedish Möbelfakta organisation. We comply with EU standards, in which the highest requirements for testing and durability for public environments are met.

Today, Johanson is an international company with 60 employees and a turnover of 210 MSEK. Our aim is to continue to expand while retaining our quality and delivery reliability standards as well as our involvement and service levels that characterize our commitment to our present customers.



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THE POODLE

The Poodle is a series with a strong, highly individualistic expression, with the various items sharing the sibling characteristics of gently rounded forms and a welcoming personality. The bold design is strikingly different, yet the look feels agreeably familiar, thanks to a flirt with historic lines. After first being exhibited in the autumn, Poodle easy chair and chair are now being launched on the market and will be followed later in the year by three sizes of matching tables.

The series was initially unveiled in autumn 2022 as part of the PLUS1 project. This project is an initiative from the designer Alexander Lervik that aims to give young female talents an opportunity to be seen in the otherwise male dominated design industry. The Poodle is the successful outcome of the very first PLUS1 project, undertaken with Anna Herrmann. With the chairs now available for sale, Johanson Design is also proud to present a new series of three tables that exhibit the same distinctive design characteristics.

In the words of Anna Herrmann herself, “Our aim has been to build on the personality and charisma that are the defining attributes of real-life poodles, and to increase the size of our own Poodle family.” The tables exhibit their own strong identity, making them eye-catching as stand-alones, while form and expression are further accentuated when the tables are teamed up with Poodle chairs.

A distinctive feature of the series, shared by both chairs and tables alike, is the covered legs that stand proud and steady on the underlying surface. Legs can be covered in a wide variety of textiles. This creates opportunities for the furnishings to exert a strong presence as a statement piece in any context, or to blend seamlessly into the rest of the setting.



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The Poodle is manufactured by Johanson in Markaryd, Sweden, where assembly and upholstery work are in the capable hands of skilled craftsmen and women. Thanks to this on-site manufacturing, Johanson offers almost limitless flexibility in terms of the colours and fabrics you can choose.

The name of the series gives a clear indication of the source of inspiration for the design. While the corona pandemic was at its peak, and pet grooming parlours remained closed, Anna spent some of her time studying pictures of well-groomed dogs. That was when she realised that coat clips and the defining characteristics that give different breeds their own unique identity can also be replicated in product design.

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ASTON & CHARLIE new additions



In 2022, Johanson launched, among other things, **ASTON** and **CHARLIE**, series designed by Johan Lindstén and Färg & Blanche respectively. **ASTON** is the stylish and ergonomic chair where the inspiration for this modern metal chair is taken from the classic Thonet chairs. **CHARLIE** is the modular sofa with endless possibilities to adapt to different environments. A modular sofa sprung from its predecessor – the **PARKER** stool. During Stockholm Furniture Fair 2023, line extensions and updates to both series will be presented.

“ASTON is a lightweight construction with fantastic ergonomic properties and an innovative design that flirts with bygone times and styles. The 3D curve of the leg frame provides a natural ‘handle’ in the back, which makes the chair easy to move in public spaces. And there is flexibility, too, in the different finishes and alternatives,” says Johan Lindstén.

During February, we get to meet ASTON with arm-rests. A further development of the model that creates additional comfort as well as a clear profile and shape.

“The idea for CHARLIE MODULAR SOFA stems from the PARKER STOOL that we designed for Johanson some years ago. We were working on sketches for new modular sofa concepts when we realised that PARKER stool had already laid the foundations for a

whole new series of seating furniture. It was as simple as that!” say Färg & Blanche, when describing what led them to embark on this expansion of the series. This is how Färg & Blanche describes the beginning of the further development of the series.

During Stockholm Furniture Fair 2023, CHARLIE will be expanded with a round table Ø90 and a corner module. Two parts that make CHARLIE even more complete.

“We can see it in use in many different settings. Choosing the metal ring in a colour to match the textile covers creates a discreetly elegant look. Alternatively, contrasting colours in the upholstery of the modular seating and the ring produce a distinctively eye-catching focus in the room,” say Färg & Blanche. available with a star base, four legs or runners, and the footstool is available with four legs or runners.

ASTON & CHARLIE are manufactured by Johanson in Markaryd, Sweden, where assembly and upholstery work are in the capable hands of skilled craftsmen and women. There is almost limitless flexibility in terms of the colours you can choose for the metal frame or the upholstered seat and back.
