## Introduction

In Split, the textile element extends further down into the construction and meets the legs of the product in a way that creates a clear connection between the soft and the structural. What appears simple is the result of a carefully resolved process, where proportions, junctions and drape have been decisive to the product's expression.

The construction is based on a split metal tube which, through its composition, creates an arch that meets the other leg. The result is a form that suggests four arches coming together. The distinctive expression emerges in the meeting between these arches and the textile element, which extends down into the construction and gives the series an organic, almost animal quality. The seams at the top of the stool meet the point of the textile and contribute to a tailored and distinctive expression.

“The meeting between the point of the textile and the metal arches is central – it is where much of the product's character emerges,” say Färg & Blanche.

Split is conceived as the beginning of a larger family. In its first launch, the series is presented as bar stools and a bench, but it has been developed with the ambition of growing over time into additional typologies, such as a low stool, an armchair and a modular sofa. The idea is to create a series that feels modular and generous in its upholstery, and that can function in many different types of environments.

The combination of metal and textile also opens great freedom in terms of colour. Split is intended to give architects and interior designers the opportunity to work with both contrasts and tone-on-tone combinations, and to explore the interplay between material, form and colour.



## Designer

Stockholm based design studio Färg & Blanche is known for their experimental stance, where each expression informs the other, they effortlessly move between the exclusive hand made one off and the industrially produced, without ever losing their distinctive touch.

## Seat - Upholstery materials

Johanson offers a very generous range of fabrics, leather and artificial leather from the most reputable suppliers in the world. Should any other material be desired despite the wide selection, it is also possible to suggest other materials. Johanson does not charge start-up costs for handling non-standard materials.

## Multicolour - Finish RAL

Take part in Johanson's color range, 410 variants of different finishes are offered as standard on steel frames and metal details. Choose from all 197 RAL colors, alternatives are available both as solid finish (gloss 72) or Structure finish which has a matte, slightly textured elegant surface. In addition, 15 RAL colors with pearl finish and chrome are offered.

## Material

The seat is made of FSC certified wood and padding is made of polyether/foam. Finished/lacquerd metal.

## Fire classification

All products meet Möbelfakta's fire requirements. All polyether/foam are tested to Cal TB 117. All standard fabrics meet EN 1021:1 & 2. Other classification, for example BS 5856 (Crib 5) on request, please contact customer support.

## Recycling

All steel parts are recyclable. Before we finish the chrome/lacquer all grease/oil is removed by alkaline wash and then sent for destruction. The lacquering is produced by electrostatic epoxy powder coating that gives a minium of waste. The electrostatic chrome (chrome 3) is recyclable. The plastic parts that are used are recyclable by grinding. All upholstery and frames of synthetic material are totally without C.F.C. emissions. All glue is water based.

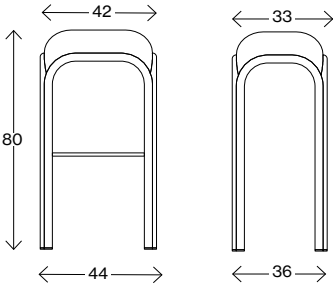

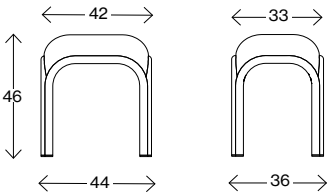
